Send your proposals via email to conf-office@german-uds.de by **October 15, 2024**. Abstract decisions will be announced by October 30, 2024. We welcome proposal for

- **Papers:** 20-minute presentations with a 10-minute discussion. Submit a title, 300word abstract, 150-word bio, up to 5 keywords and 3 references.
- **Workshops:** 90-minute interactive sessions. Submit a title, 300-word abstract, 150word bio per chair, up to 5 keywords and 3 references, participant count, and equipment needs.
- **Symposia:** 90-minute sessions with 3-4 related papers. Include a thematic intro, titles, 300-word abstracts, up to 5 keywords and 3 references per paper, and 150word bios for each speaker.
- **Displays/Demos:** Media exhibits or installations. Submit a title, 300-word abstract, 150-word bio, up to 5 keywords and 3 references, media samples. Indicate demo/showroom preferences.
